

Kilkenny Library Wi-Fi Policy

1. Wi-Fi use is available for current members of the Library. Visitors may also use the service - enquire at Library desk for details.
2. Children under 18 yrs may use the Internet, provided that the Guarantor section of the Library membership application form is signed by parent/ guardian at registration or renewal. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children's internet usage.
3. Children under 12 years using the Internet must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult.
4. You must not obstruct the work of other library users and/or staff. Please ensure that power cables etc. do not become a trip hazard. Please note that there may be more users than power sockets available; the charging of your device is your responsibility.
5. You should refer to your device's manual for help in configuring your device settings. Library staff cannot assist in trouble-shooting.
6. Please note that on occasions the Wi-Fi service may be unavailable due to technical reasons that are beyond the control of library staff.
7. Users may not create, access, copy, store, transmit, download or publish any material which: is obscene, racist, defamatory or illegal; causes harassment or gross offence to others and/or constitutes a breach of copyright laws or licensing agreements.
8. Filter software and monitoring are in place.
9. Privacy of Internet users cannot be guaranteed. (For more information please see our **WiFi Safety Tips**.)
10. Kilkenny County Library Service is not responsible for any information found on the Internet. Individuals use the information at their own discretion.
11. Users who fail to observe the above conditions will have their access to the service withdrawn.
