## Door- to- door library delivery service an overwhelming success!



ilkenny County **Council library** service developed a new model of service delivery - a door to door service for the over 70's in response to the challenges faced during Covid-19 by many older library members. It supports the national wellbeing campaign **#InthisTogether and** helps make life a little bit easier on those cocooning.







How it works is Kilkenny County Council library service contacts members who are over 70 years and asks them if they interested in a delivery of books / audio material to their doorstep. The service is being rolled out to all members over 70 on a branch by branch basis.

The offering is for 3 x library items per person and members are asked to choose their preference of books, audiobooks, and large print and the type/genre they would like to receive. The parcel also contains some useful information/items in relation to health and wellbeing.



Kilkenny County Council branch and H.Q. library staff assist in choosing the books and preparing the parcels and having built relationships over many years with their members they are in a unique position to know their member's reading tastes.



Our mobile library driver, Tom Kirwan, has been collecting the book parcels from the different library branches before delivering them directly to members in their homes across the county.

To date deliveries have taken place in Callan, Castlecom-



er, Graiguenamanagh, Thomastown, Loughboy and mobile library members. Urlingford staff are selecting and packing their books for delivery at the moment, with Ferrybank and City Library members over 70 to be contacted next.

Over 450 library members have been contacted so far about the service and 684 books have been delivered to homes around the County.

Stringent health and safety measures are adhered to throughout the process of choosing, packaging and delivering the books and all HSE guidelines are incorporated into the model.
