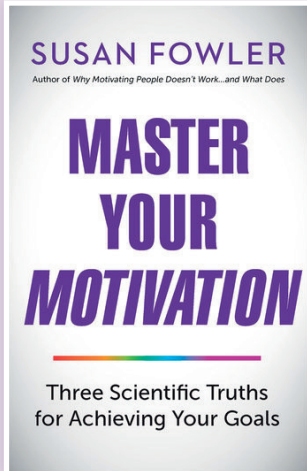

Kilkenny Library-pointing you in the right direction!

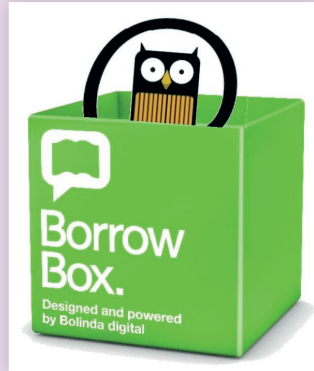


September usually suggests new beginnings but this year it's approach feels different. Don't worry we here at Kilkenny Library will do our best to steer you in the right direction.

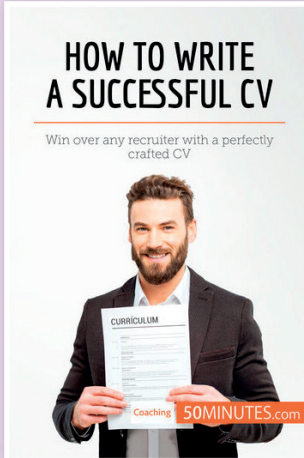

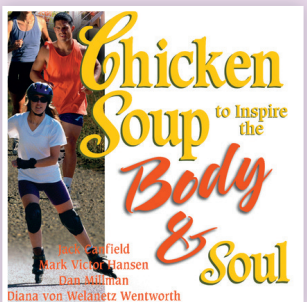
