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
Sensory Toys and Books in Kilkenny Library

Kilkenny Library have been working closely with ASIAM on an Autism friendly charter. ASI-AM is Ireland's National Autism Charity who are working to create a society in which every autistic person is empowered to reach their own personal potential and fully participate in society. We in Kilkenny Library aim to provide an accessible library service for everyone in our community. This charter helps us to be mindful of how we can promote autism awareness and autism acceptance in our libraries.



We have recently launched a Sensory Book Collection. This is available for children, parents, teachers and carers. This book collection complements our Toy and resources collection already available. These collections are available by contacting your local library branch or our Library Headquarters.

















The Toy collection provides free access to specialised toys to assist children with special needs. These toys are designed to support the development of important skills including gross motor skills, communication skills and visual perception skills.




Our sensory book collection is a specialised collection available to borrow from Kilkenny Library Headquarters. This collection of books has been purchased with advice from professionals working with children with special needs. The collection contains over 300 titles for children, young adults, parents and carers.













How do you avail of these services?

How To Do It?

- Contact either your local library branch or our Library Headquarters
- To borrow the toys, you will need a letter of referral. Teachers and SNAs will get this letter from their school principal, parents from a health professional working with their child
- To borrow both toys and books you will need to set up a new library card for sensory services.
- All these services are free and library staff will be happy to help.



There is a sensory box available also in all of our library buildings and on our mobile library, with small calming toys that can be used during your visit to help make the sensory experience better for your child. Ear defenders are also available for those with sound sensitivities.
